

REPLACING CONTROL

1. Remove back from chair
2. Turn chair upside down, holding onto cylinder, lift chair up off of floor
3. Using a rubber mallet, pound around seat of chair to remove seat from cylinder.
 Seat is on with a pressure fit so will come apart from cylinder
 It will take several hard hits around the seat to get it loose from cylinder
 It is okay to use a little WD40 if necessary
4. Turn seat upside down.
5. Remove the four screws holding the control onto the seat.
6. Place the new control on top of the four ¼" black washers.
7. Place washers on screws and tighten control onto seat.
8. Replace seat on cylinder and press into place.
9. Replace back on chair.
